1. We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain. ***II Corinthians 6:1***
2. Giving no offense in anything that the ministry be not blamed.  
***II Corinthians 6:3***
3. But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God.  
***II Corinthians 6:4***
4. Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. ***Galatians 5:1***
4. I can do all things through Christ which strengthened me.  
***Philippians 4:13***
6. But my God shall supply all your needs according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.  
***Philippians 4:19***
7. But godliness with contentment is great gain. ***I Timothy 6:6***
8. Finally brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. ***Philippians 4:8***
9. Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts. ***Zechariah 4:6***
10. Thou wilt keep him imperfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee; because he trusted in thee. ***Isaiah 26:3***
11. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him. ***Isaiah 59:19***
12. Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear. ***Isaiah 59:11***
13. Be ye not equally yoked together with unbelievers. ***II Corinthians 6:14***
14. Can two walk together, except they be agreed? ***Amos 3:3***
15. For God has not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. ***II Timothy 1:7***
16. Be not deceived; evil communications corrupt good manners.

***I Corinthians 15:33***

17. Because greater is he that is in you than he that is in the world.  
***I John 4:4***
18. There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, bur after the Spirit. ***Romans 8:1***
19. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.  
***Romans 12:1***
20. Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.  
***I Corinthians 6:19***
21. What? Know ye not your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God and ye are not your own? ***I Corinthians 6:19***
22. For ye are brought with a price; therefore, glorify God in your body and your spirit; which are God's. ***I Corinthians 6:20***
23. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds. ***II Corinthians 10:4***
24. Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.  
***II Corinthians 10:5***
25. But they measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise. ***II Corinthians 10:12***
26. So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. ***Romans 10:17***
27. For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south.  
***Psalms 75:6***
28. But God is the judge; he putteth down one, and setteth up another. ***Psalms 75:7***
29. And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.  
***Ephesians 5:11***
30. For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.  
***Ephesians 5:12***

31. Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.  
*Ephesians 5:14*
32. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. *Romans 1:16*
33. Because that when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were they thankful; but became vain in their imagination, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools. *Romans 1:21-22*
34. And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind to do those things which are not convenient. *Romans 1:28*
35. How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity: and the scorers delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge? *Proverbs 1:22*
36. The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?  
*Jeremiah 17:9*
37. Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. *Psalms 139:23-24*
38. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to thy word. With my whole heart I have sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments. Thy word have I hid my heart that I might not sin against thee.  
*Psalms 119:9-11*
39. My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness.  
*II Corinthians 12:9*
40. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.  
*St. John 14:12*
41. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. *St. John 15:7*
42. To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to his word, it is because there is no light in them. *Isaiah 8:20*
43. For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edged sword, piercing even to the divine asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart. *Hebrews 4:12*

44. If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sins, and will heal their land. *II Chronicles 7:14*
45. For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. *II Chronicles 16:9*
46. In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence save them: in his love and his pity he redeemed them, and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old. *Isaiah 63:10*
47. But they rebelled, and vexed his holy spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, and fought against them. *Isaiah 63:10*
48. Then they cried unto the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distress. *Psalms 107:6*
49. Oh that men would praise the Lord for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! *Psalms 107:8*
50. Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy. *Psalms 107:2*
51. He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. *Psalms 107:20*
52. Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. *Ephesians 6:10*
53. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. *Ephesians 6:11*
54. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. *Ephesians 6:12*
55. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. *Ephesians 6:13*
56. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness. *Ephesians 6:14*
57. And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; *Ephesians 6:15*
58. Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. *Ephesians 6:16*

58. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all preservance and supplication for all saints. *Ephesians 6:18*
60. Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. *Ephesians 4:3*
61. And he gave some apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; *Ephesians 4:11*
62. For the perfecting of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ. *Ephesians 4:12*
63. Till we all come in the unity of faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. *Ephesians 4:13*
64. That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; *Ephesians 4:14*
65. Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying that it may minister grace unto the hearers. *Ephesians 4:29*
66. And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. *Ephesians 4:30*
67. For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: *Isaiah 55:10*
68. So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. *Isaiah 55:11*
69. Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall me make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. *Isaiah 28:9*
70. For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: *Isaiah 28:10*
71. For I will hasten my word to perform it. *Jeremiah 1:12*
72. Thine own wickedness shall correct thee, and thy backslidings shall reprove thee: know therefore and see that it is an evil thing and bitter, that thou hast forsaken the Lord thy God. *Jeremiah 2:19*
73. This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind. *Ephesians 4:17*

74. Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart. ***Ephesians 4:18***
75. If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceable with all men. ***Romans 12:18***
76. Let all things be done decently and in order. ***I Corinthians 14:40***
77. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ***Hebrews 11:1***
78. For we walk by faith, and not by sight. ***II Corinthians 5:7***
79. But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of those who diligently seek him. ***Hebrews 11:6***
80. Is any among you afflicted? Let him pray. Is any merry? Let him sing psalms. ***James 5:13***
81. Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let hem pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ***James 5:14***
82. And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. ***James 5:15***
83. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. ***James 5:16***
84. Be careful for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your request be made known unto God. ***Philippians 4:6***
85. Let this mind be in you, which is also in Christ Jesus. ***Philippians 2:5***
86. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do his good pleasure. ***Philippians 2:13***
87. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. ***Colossians 3:2***
88. Study to shew thyself approve unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. ***II Timothy 2:15***
89. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness. ***I Timothy 3:16***
90. That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. ***II Timothy 3:17***

91. Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.  
***II Peter 1:20***
92. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. ***II Peter 1:21***
93. As new born babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby.  
***I Peter 2:2***
94. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;  
***II Peter 1:5***
95. And to knowledge temperance, and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;  
***II Peter 1:6***
96. And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, charity. ***II Peter 1:7***
97. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. ***II Peter 1:8***
98. But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sin. ***II Peter 1:9***
99. Wherefore, the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling an election sure; for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall. ***II Peter 1:10***
100. That thy trust may be in the Lord, I have made known to thee this day, even to thee.  
***Proverbs 22:19***
101. That I might make thee know the certainty of the words of truth; that thou mightiest answer the word of truth to them that send unto thee? ***Proverbs 22:20***
102. Believe in the Lord your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper. ***I Chronicles 20:20***
103. In the day of my trouble I will call upon thee: for thou wilt answer me. ***Psalms 86:7***
104. Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.  
***Proverbs 3:5***
105. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. ***Proverbs 3:6***
106. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. ***Proverbs 4:7***

107. Delight thyself also in the Lord; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.  
*Psalms 37:4*
108. Commit thy way unto the Lord; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.  
*Psalms 37:5*
109. Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright: for the end of man is peace. *Psalms 37:37*
110. Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call upon him while he is near. *Isaiah 55:6*
111. Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him return unto the Lord; and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. *Isaiah 55:7*
112. For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord.  
*Isaiah 55:8*
113. Israel hath cast off the thing that is good: the enemy shall pursue him. *Hosea 8:3*
114. And all thy children shall be taught of the Lord; and great shall be the peace of thy children. *Isaiah 54:13*
115. And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.  
*Isaiah 62:7*
116. Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, and Israel had walked in my ways! I should soon have subdued their enemies, and turned my hand against their adversaries.  
*Psalms 81:13-14*
117. Great men are not always wise: neither do the aged understand judgment. *Job 32:9*
118. Mischief shall come upon mischief, and rumor shall be upon rumor; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients. *Ezekiel 7:26*
119. My heart is toward the governors of Israel, that offered themselves willingly among the people. Bless ye the people. *Judges 5:9*
120. Whoso boasteth himself of a false gift is like clouds and wind without rain.  
*Proverbs 25:14*
121. Though a sinner do evil a hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him. *Ecclesiastes 8:12*

122. An alter of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen; in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee. **Exodus 20:24**
123. And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehospaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the Lord your God, shall ye be established; believe in His prophets, so shall ye prosper. **II Chronicles 20:20**
124. He that hideth hatred with lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander is a fool. **Proverbs 10:18**
125. Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised is wisdom. **Proverbs 13:10**
126. Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou are taken with the words of thy mouth. Do this now my son, and deliver thyself when thou art come into the hand of thy friend; go humble thyself, and make sure of thy friend. Give not sleep to thine eyes, nor slumber to thine eyelids. Deliver thyself as a roe from the hand of the hunter, and as a bird from the hand of the fowler. **Proverbs 6:2-5**
127. Say unto wisdom, Thou art my sister; and call understanding thy kinswoman: that they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger with flattereth with her word. **Proverbs 7:4-5**
128. As for my people, children are their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause thee to err, and to destroy the way of thy paths. **Isaiah 3:12**
129. Whoredom and wine and new wine take away the heart. **Hosea 4:11**
130. Hear the word of the Lord, ye children of Israel: for the Lord hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, no mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. **Hosea 4:1**
131. Now therefore thus saith the Lord of Hosts; Consider your ways. Ye looked for much, and, lo, it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the Lord of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house. **Haggai 1:5,9**
132. He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, He reproveth Kings for their sakes; saying, Touch not mine anointed and do my prophets no harm. **Psalms 105:14-15**
133. But he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up. Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch. **St. Matthew 15:13,14**

134. But he answered and said, it is written, man shall not live by bread alone but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. *St. Matthew 4:4*
135. He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.  
*Psalms 103:10*
136. O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? for your goodness is as a mourning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away. *Hosea 6:4*
137. In the light of the king's countenance is life: and his favor is as a cloud of the latter rain.  
*Proverbs 16:15*
138. But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit done unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wraught upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.  
*II Chronicles 32:25*
139. Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets: How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorers delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge. *Proverbs 1:20,22*
140. This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thy shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.  
*Joshua 1:8*
140. But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swears unto thy fathers, as it is this day. *Deuteronomy 8:18*
142. And thou mourn at last, when thy flesh and thy body are consumed, and say, how have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof; and have not obeyed the voice of my teachers, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me! *Proverbs 5:11-13*
143. These things hast thou done, and I kept silence; thou thoughtest that I was altogether such an one as thyself; but I will reprove thee, and set them in order before thine eyes.

144. Behold, thou desireth truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. *Psalms 51:6*
